Old Testament SOLOMON'S TEMPLE 1 Kings chapter 6

King Solomon had many talents. He was very wise, wrote poetry, was a clever judge of difficult cases, and he knew how to gather great wealth. He was also a talented builder. King David had really wanted to build a Temple to the Lord, but the Lord told him (2 Samuel 7: 1-13) that he was not to build the Temple. Instead, God would give this task to David's son.

Solomon built the Temple before building the palace. Before the Temple was built, the people had been sacrificing "on the high places," which means that their religious customs were a little like the pagans who lived all around. Bringing the worship to a certain place in Jerusalem would bring the priests and the people together. The Temple Solomon built was very grand! But it didn't last forever.

New Testament BLIND BARTIMAEUS Mark 10: 35-45

Jericho is a city with a long history. It is called the Oldest City in the World, dating back to 9,000 years before Jesus was born, or 11,000 years before now. We know about Jericho from the Old Testament stories. Also, the story of the Good Samaritan is set on the road to Jericho. One day when Jesus and his disciples were walking to Jericho, many people were standing by the roadside hoping for a chance to talk to Jesus. A blind man, the son of Timaeus (Bar means "son of") was so excited that Jesus was passing by that he shouted these famous words, "Jesus, son of David, have mercy on me!" Jesus asked him what he wanted. He wanted to see! Jesus restored his sight. Bartimaeus started to follow Jesus down the road.

Usually completed by 11:45 AM. Enjoy the prepared meal for lunch with the other volunteers. Final cleanup and leave, usually by 1 PM.

SOS started to serve the poor in 1980, originally serving the meal downtown Seattle. In 2013 we moved our service to our own neighbors in the Northshore area. Our meals and food passed on to community shelters and foodbanks serves approximately 10,000 meals a year.

Without someone stepping forward, we will have to stop preparing food for those less fortunate in our community.
