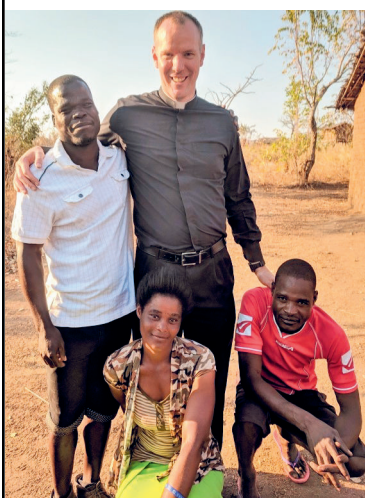

Old Testament ELIJAH AND OBADIAH 1 Kings chapter 18

Elijah was hard to find when he wanted to hide. After he predicted a time of no rain, he stayed away from King Ahab until God sent him back to Samaria. Samaria is the country north of Judah. Because of the drought, Obadiah and King Ahab were out looking for water for the animals. Suddenly Obadiah spotted Elijah.

Obadiah was a faithful servant of the Lord. When the wicked Queen Jezebel started killing the prophets of the Lord, Obadiah personally hid 100 of them in 2 caves and supplied food and water for them. But he was not prepared for what Elijah said.

Elijah said, "Go tell your master Ahab that I am here." Obadiah argued with Elijah at first because Ahab had been looking for Elijah for years. But when he realized that God had sent Elijah, he finally took the message to Ahab.

New Testament JESUS PURIFIES THE TEMPLE Mark 11: 15-20

After his entry into Jerusalem, Jesus must have headed straight to the Temple. Ordinary people were buying animals to sacrifice. After the sacrifices (a way to say thank you to God and to show sorrow for sins) the families ate together near the Temple. Money changers were making plenty of money by demanding too much money for each animal they sold. They also changed regular money into Temple money and often cheated. Jesus drove out the people who were buying and selling. He even overturned the money tables and upset the bird cages. You can look at Isaiah 56:7 or Jeremiah 7:11 to see other times when the prophets had upset Temple business in order to call people back to the true worship of God.

MY FAITH: The Blessed TRINITY

"Hear, O Israel:
The Lord our God is
one Lord." Christians
believe in One God in
Three Persons. God the
Father has always made
himself known to his
people. When Jesus
came to earth, he
showed us that God is
One in Three Persons,
which we call the
Blessed Trinity. Unity
means ONE and Trinity
means THREE. You can
draw a triangle to help
you think of God. You
can think of the Father
and the Son and the
Holy Spirit as different
angles to the triangle,
but still one shape, or
different lines but still
one shape. The Father
sent the Son to us. The
Son sends us the Holy
Spirit, and the Holy
Spirit sends us right
back to the Father.
