Old Testament **ELIJAH MEETS ELISHA** **1 Kings 19: 19-21**

Elijah was well known in Israel after he defeated the prophets of Baal and Asherah. Also, he had predicted a three year time of no rain, and he was the first to see the tiny raincloud when it appeared. After these adventures he met Elisha, who was plowing a field with oxen. He threw his cloak over Elisha, a sign that meant he was following God's orders to choose Elisha. Just like the disciples who left everything to follow Jesus, Elisha immediately ran away from the oxen and decided to follow Elijah. First he wanted to kiss his mother and father and prepare a feast for the field workers. After that, he did follow Elijah. Other prophets knew that Elisha was Elijah's assistant. They too received messages from God.

New Testament **MORE QUESTIONS FOR JESUS** **Mark 12: 18-37**

Following Jesus's footsteps during Holy Week, we find him talking to many people. Some wanted to hear Jesus's wisdom and others wanted to catch him saying something wrong.

Marriage The question came up—If a man or a woman loses their wife or husband, they might marry again. Then when the dead are raised, how will we know which wife belongs to which husband? Jesus said "When people rise from the dead they neither marry nor are given in marriage."

Commandment Someone asked Jesus which was the greatest commandment. Jesus answered with two commandments 1) to love the Lord your God, and 2) to love your neighbor as yourself.

King David's son? Jesus said that the Messiah is Lord of King David, and not his son.

The EUCHARIST

What is happening when we go to Mass? What is the Eucharist? It is a mystery, something so wonderful that if you thought about the Eucharist all your life, you would still be thinking about it when you were very old. Saint Paul said in 1 Corinthians 11: 23-25, "The Lord Jesus on the night in which he was betrayed took bread, and after he had given thanks, broke it and said, 'This is my body, which is for you. Do this in remembrance of me.'" And Jesus said that the cup was the blood of the new covenant. It seems sometimes that Mass is long, but actually it is very short, much shorter than a game or a movie. We go to the Eucharist because all the words and the actions help us to worship Jesus the same way he is worshiped in Heaven.
