Old Testament

THE CHARIOT OF FIERY HORSES

2 Kings 2: 1-14

Elijah was a great prophet of Israel who struggled against idol worship. He was sent many times to kings with messages from God. But he was not without fear. More than once he asked God to let him die. Toward the end of his ministry the prophet Elisha joined him and traveled wherever the Spirit of God took Elijah. One day Elijah kept trying to leave Elisha behind, but he would not be separated from his teacher. Suddenly between the two of them appeared a flaming chariot with fiery horses, and Elijah was scooped up into the chariot and carried off to heaven in a great whirlwind. Elisha looked on until he could no longer see anything. Elijah had promised that if Elisha was able to see the miracle, that he would inherit a double portion of Elijah's spirit, and that is exactly what happened.

New Testament

THE PROPHECIES IN JERUSALEM

Mark chapter 13

When we read Jesus's prophecies from Holy Week we realize that Jesus was warning the people about what would happen next. Prophets bring messages from God. Some of these messages foretell the future. What kind of events was Jesus predicting? He said that the great temple built by Herod the Great would be torn down. Not even one stone would be left on another. Jesus told his disciples that many people would try to pretend to be Jesus, that there would be wars and reports of wars, plus natural disasters such as earthquakes. On a more personal note, he shared with his disciples that their lives would not be safe, that they would be hated by many. But at the very end of time the Messiah would come back.

MY FAITH— Our Church Calendar

Our Church calendar is different from the calendars on our walls. Instead of 4 seasons, we have 6. Remember these colors:

purple white **green**

Advent is a purple season, the 4 Sundays before Christmas.

Christmas is a white season, the 12 days from December 25 to January 5.

Ordinary time is green, from January 6 to the Tuesday before Ash Wednesday.

Lent is a purple season, exactly 40 days not counting Sundays.

Easter is 50 days from Easter Sunday to Pentecost.

Ordinary time is green, about 6 months from Pentecost to Advent.

KNIGHTS CORNER



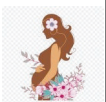
