#### Old Testament NAAMAN THE LEPER 2 Kings 5: 1-27

Naaman was the commander of the armies of Aram. He had the dreaded disease of leprosy. In his household was a little slave girl from Israel who had been captured in a raid. She worked for Naaman's wife. When she heard that the master had leprosy she spoke up, saying that in Israel a prophet could ask God for a cure. The king of Aram thought that the king of Israel could cure leprosy! Elisha came to the rescue and told Naaman to wash seven times in the Jordan river. Naaman was angry. Why should he wash in the Jordan? But his servant convinced him to at least try what the prophet had ordered, and he was miraculously healed. He wanted to pay for the miracles, but Elisha refused payment. However, Elisha's servant Gehazi ran after Naaman and asked for payment. Gehazi became a leper because he tried to sell the miracle.

#### New Testament LAST SUPPER—FIRST EUCHARIST Mark 14: 22-31

During the Passover meal that Jesus celebrated with his disciples. he took bread, blessed and broke it, and gave it to them. He said the words which we call the words of Institution—"Take this, this is my body." And with the wine, as he passed the blessed wine to his disciples Jesus said, "This is my blood...to be poured out...I will never again drink of the fruit of the vine until the day when I drink it new in the reign of God." They sang a song of praise. Don't you wish you could have heard the singing? Jesus warned that the faith of all the disciples would be shaken. Peter thought he would remain faithful, but Jesus told Peter that he would deny his Lord three times.
