Old Testament THE TEMPLE IS REBUILT Ezra chapters 6-10

The work on the temple in Jerusalem stopped until the government in Babylon could find the old decree from King Cyrus that the temple should be rebuilt. However, after a time of waiting and not getting an answer from Babylon, a man named Zerubbabel started the building project again, encouraged by the prophets of God. When a Babylonian official asked them what they were doing, they replied that they served God the king of heaven who had ordered them to rebuild the temple. They weren't going to wait. Fortunately for everyone, the permission that Cyrus had granted was found in the government library. Work continued. Soon they were able to worship in the temple and offer sacrifices. Ezra discovered that many of the Jews had married women who were not Jewish. They sent away their wives and children, to the grief and sorrow of many people.

New Testament BABY JESUS IS BORN Luke 2: 1-20

Mary and Joseph lived in Nazareth, far to the north. It was a long trip down to Bethlehem near Jerusalem. However, they had to make that trip even though Mary was pregnant, because Caesar Augustus the ruler of Rome decided he wanted a census, or a head-count, of all the people in the Roman empire. Each family was to go to the city of their ancestors. We often see pictures of Mary riding a donkey into Bethlehem. We hope she had the help of a donkey, though the Bible doesn't tell us.

When they arrived in Bethlehem there were only wide open covered areas for the people to spend the night. They were helped by a kind man who let them stay in the same cave as his animals. And there the Son of God was born.
