MALAWI MOMENT

Greetings from Malawi. We hope you are all doing fine. We are fine here despite heavy rains to the extent of floods in other parts of the country. Be informed as well that the mechanic came to examine the truck and found out that apart from the leakages in the fuel tank and the cracks on the wind screen, the radiator also got damaged as well as the wiper motor. The car needs a revamp of the breaking system by replacing all those parts that have not been working well which were the main cause of the accident. The front bumper needs some panel beating. Some tiled ends also need some replacement. He estimated the whole work and the cost of the required spare parts at around MK400,000 which is about US\$550. Having examined the vehicle, I have so far advised him to produce an invoice on the same. Any day next week I intend to tow the car to Mangochi where the maintenance will take place. I intend to partly ask for assistance from our health facilities for the maintenance. Any amount that you can assist with will be highly appreciated.

Old Testament INTRODUCING NEHEMIAH Nehemiah 1: 1—2: 6

Ezra was the great religious man who brought back the temple worship as the city of Jerusalem was being rebuilt. Nehemiah was the one who took charge of the hard work of rebuilding. Nehemiah was one of the Jewish people who was born during the time of the exile into Babylon. He worked in one of the great Babylonian cities—Susa—as the wine server for King Artaxerxes. Nehemiah had just heard a report that Jerusalem was n ruins with its gates torn down and destroyed by fire.

King Artaxerxes asked Nehemiah why he was sad. He answered that the city his people came from was in ruins. The king and queen arranged for Nehemiah to go back to Jerusalem and help with the rebuilding.

New Testament BABY JESUS IS PRESENTED Luke 2: 22-40

When Jesus was eight days old, he was taken to the Temple to be presented to the Lord. Moses had decreed that "Every first-born male shall be consecrated to the Lord." (Exodus chapter 13) The parents would offer the sacrifice of 2 turtledoves or 2 pigeons.

While they were there, a very old man named Simeon was led by the Holy Spirit to go to the Temple. He took baby Jesus in his arms and blessed God in a great prayer of thanksgiving that Christians still pray. "Now Lord, let your servant depart in peace. For my eyes have seen your salvation... A light to enlighten the nations and the glory of your people Israel."

Jesus was also blessed by the Prophetess Anna. She gave thanks to God for the child.

In the parable of the **Good Samaritan.** Jesus chose some people who were ancient enemies to illustrate that even those who were not part of the Chosen People still responded to human suffering in a way that pleased
