TOBIAH AND SARAH MARRY

Tobit 7: 1-17

Tobiah son of Tobit was in love with a young lady named Sarah. Tobiah was from the Jewish extended family group descended from Naphtali, one of Jacob's grandsons. Joseph had two sons named Ephraim and Naphtali. Their people had been carried off to exile by the Assyrians in 721 BC. They had made the best life for themselves that they could in a strange new environment. Tobiah was on a journey to meet Raguel, a friend of his father Tobit. The difficulty in marrying Sarah was that Sarah had already been married seven times and each time the husband had been killed by a demon. But Tobiah had the help of the archangel Rafael, traveling under the name Azariah. So Tobiah wasn't afraid to marry Sarah. The parents, however, feared the worst as the marriage took place.

New Testament

THE DEMONS RECOGNIZE JESUS

Luke 4: 33-44

When Jesus became incarnate, taking on our human nature, we read in the Bible that the demons were terrified because they knew who Jesus was, and that he had power and authority to drive them out. In the synagogue (Jewish place of worship) in Capernaum, a demon (also called an unclean spirit) who had inhabited a man's body shrieked out, "Leave us alone! What do you want with us, Jesus of Nazareth? Have you come to destroy us? I know who you are: the Holy One of God." Jesus commanded the unclean spirit to come out of the man, and also to be quiet. People were amazed that the unclean spirits obeyed his words. At the same time, Peter's mother in law was sick with a fever. Jesus healed her and she quietly rose up and waited on him. Many with unclean spirits came to Jesus and he healed many people there.




