### **Old Testament**

#### **JEREMIAH THE YOUNG PROPHET**

##### **Jeremiah Chapter 1**

Josiah was a good king. He loved God and led his people wisely. The Bible says, "He pleased the Lord." Josiah repaired the temple during his reign. But his son King Jehoiakim and his grandson King Zedekiah did not follow the laws of Moses.

Jeremiah was called by the Lord to go to Jerusalem. Many years before, his ancestors of the priestly family of Abiathar had been sent away by King Saul. So when Jeremiah came to Jerusalem and said he was from the village of Anathoth, everyone guessed that his message from God might be so strong that the kings would not want to hear it.
