Old Testament

JUDITH TAKES THE LEAD

Judith 8: 9–31

The people of Jerusalem knew that Holofernes, the Assyrian general, had defeated city after city as he marched west. Jerusalem would be just one more city in his path. However, Holofernes was confused. Most of the cities sent out messengers asking for peace. Most people knew that their city could not survive a battle with such a strong army. But the Jews were fortifying the mountain passes and getting ready for war. Holofernes wondered, did they think they could actually defeat his army? The people of Jerusalem, led by Uzziah, were in constant prayer. They decided to give God 5 more days to save them, and if God didn't save them, then they would surrender. Judith couldn't believe her ears! She had never heard of giving God a timeline—"Either save us in 5 days or we stop trusting You." Judith insisted that she had a plan. She convinced the elders to pray for her and to give up the idea of surrender.

New Testament

JESUS AND THE SABBATH

Luke 6: 1-11

God created the world in 6 days and on the 7th day he rested. (Genesis 2: 1 & 2.) One thing that happens in our families and our communities, is that people work too hard. Older people in the Church can remember when almost no stores were open on Sundays. People went to church in the morning, read the newspaper, ate a big dinner and then went out for a Sunday drive. There were no video games or cell phones and they didn't go to the movies. In the Jewish community the special day has always been Saturday (Sabbath). When Jesus was on earth, the laws were quite strict about the Sabbath. You could get in big trouble for doing any work. Jesus's disciples picked some grain to eat. Jesus healed a man with a withered hand on the Sabbath. He taught that the Sabbath is for worshiping God and helping God's people.

MY FAITH

What is a prayer of PETITION?

Most of our prayers are for somebody else. Is it ok to pray for something for yourself? What does Jesus say about that idea? In the Lord's prayer we say, "Give us this day our daily bread." So yes, it's ok to pray for food. "Forgive us our trespasses." We can ask for forgiveness. "Lead us not into temptation." We can ask for guidance. "Deliver us from evil." We can ask for safety. What else can we ask for? We can ask for everything that is good! St. James says, "You do not receive because you do not ask."
