SPIRITUAL ADOPTION UPDATE—THIRD MONTH "I CAN SUCK MY THUMB NOW"

Our spiritual adopted babies are now 3 inches. The baby sleeps, awakens and exercises his muscles energetically, moving his toes, and opening and closing his mouth. Fingernails and toenails form and he now has his own unique set of fingerprints. Sensitive to touch, he will tightly grasp an object placed in the palm of his hand. He breathes amniotic fluid to help develop and strengthen the respiratory system, but he gets the oxygen he needs through the umbilical cord. He can now squint, swallow and move his tongue. In fact, early this month around week 9-he began to suck his thumb.
