

Old Testament

ESTHER IS BROUGHT TO COURT

Esther chapters 1 & 2

These days women have a lot of freedom that they didn't have in the Bible times. For one thing, in our culture women choose who they want to marry. In Esther's world it wasn't that way. So Esther was nervous but probably happy when she found that King Ahasuerus was looking for a wife. He had lots of wives, which was the custom in his culture. But he decided that beautiful Esther would become his queen. Esther didn't tell anyone that she was a Jew. She was following her uncle Mordecai's direction in this as in everything. In one version of the book of Esther, it is Esther who tells the king of the plot against his life.

Haman, the enemy of Mordecai the Jew, gained enough power that people were supposed to bow down to the ground to him as soon as they saw him, which Mordecai refused to do. Haman was extremely angry. He wanted the king to kill all the Jews.

New Testament

THE WIDOW'S SON

Luke 7: 11-23

Jesus was traveling through a town called Naim, still in the area of Galilee, far to the north of Jerusalem. As he came near the gate, he could see a funeral procession. The body being carried was of a fairly young man, the only son of a widow. Without her husband and her son, she had no one to care for her. Jesus said to her, "Do not cry." He walked up to the dead man and told him to get up. How amazed the crowd was when Jesus restored the young man alive to his mother.

John the Baptist had disciples. John had a question for Jesus. Was he the Messiah? Should they look for someone else? Jesus told John's disciples to go back to John and report what they were seeing and hearing. The blind were receiving their sight. The deaf were receiving their hearing. Crippled people were now walking, and even the dead were being raised to life

When we pray the Our Father, also called the Lord's Prayer, we are using the very words that Jesus taught to his disciples. We realize the close relationship in the name Father. We recognize that God is in heaven and that his name is to be honored. We ask for his will to be done everywhere.
