#### **ESTHER'S BANQUETS**

#### **Esther chapters D & 5**

Esther made up her mind to try to speak directly to the King. If she went into the palace courtroom without permission the law said she could be killed, unless the king Ahasuerus would hold out his scepter toward her. A scepter is a long beautiful stick, a symbol of royal power. Queen Elizabeth of England has a scepter.

Esther was so nervous she fainted. But she looked so brave and beautiful that the king did hold out his scepter toward her. He was very gentle with her and asked her what she wanted to say.

She didn't yet tell the king that Haman was planning to kill all the Jews. Instead, she invited the king and Haman to a banquet. Later at a second banquet, she accused Haman of arranging to kill all the Jews. The King punished him as he deserved.

#### **New Testament**

#### **THE PARABLE OF THE SOWER**

#### **Luke 8: 4-15**

Some of Jesus's parables are hard to understand. But the Parable of the Sower is easily understood because Jesus explained it to his band of disciples.

A sower is someone who plants seeds in order to get a harvest of wheat or other grains.

In the story, the sower scattered the wheat seeds as he went along. Some of the seeds fell on rocky ground where they withered because they didn't have water. Other seeds fell on the path and the birds ate them up. And other seeds fell into thorn bushes where the thorns choked them out.

Happily, some seeds fell on good soil, growing into great stalks of wheat that would feed the village. When we listen to God's word and follow Jesus, we are like those seeds that fell on the rich soil.

## MALAWI ELECTIONS

Malawi gained independence from Great Britain in 1964. They are a multi-party democracy. Here is Fr. Davie's statements regarding the recent election whereby the incumbent was challenged by two candidates who promised change that would address the problems of poverty, the economy and government corruption. *"I am looking forward for change and supporting the vice president and his party, however, if he doesn't get elected, I have no problem with the main opposition as long as we change from the current government."* Unfortunately, the incumbent Peter Mutharika was reelected in a tight race by 150,000 votes out of approximately 7 million. There were complaints of voter fraud but a court injunction was vacated. We are praying for peace. A celebration at Sunday Mass at St. Joseph was held to welcome Fr. Fanuel, the new assistant priest.
