Old Testament

ANTIOCHUS EPIPHANES

1 Maccabees chapter 1

Alexander the Great conquered most of the known world, even venturing as far as India. When he died at age 33 a lot of confusion followed, as all his friends and officers wanted to gain as much power as possible.

The Jews had always tried to keep away from other cultures and live with the laws God had given them in the 10 Commandments. But this was very difficult to do, especially as they were well educated, intelligent people who spent time with the powerful people of the world.

One powerful person, Antiochus Epiphanes, was a Gentile (not Jewish) who pretended to be friendly with the Jews while he was conquering Egypt. After he felt his kingdom was secure, he began to persecute the Jews. He started this persecution by stealing the altar and all the beautiful worship items that belonged to the temple.

New Testament

TWO GREAT MIRACLES

Luke 8: 22-39

One of the ways that we know Jesus is divine is that He did many miracles on earth that were reported by eye witnesses.

Jesus fell asleep in a boat that the disciples were rowing across the Sea of Galilee. As he was peacefully sleeping a huge storm came up and the disciples thought they were all going to drown. Jesus woke and commanded the wind and the waves to be still.

Unclean spirits called demons had taken over a man's life. He became so wild that he lived among the tombstones. Jesus healed him, restoring him to his right mind. He sent the demons into a herd of pigs that ran over a cliff into the sea and were drowned. The townspeople were angry with Jesus and wanted him to go away. Jesus told the healed man to glorify God and to tell his story to everyone.

MY FAITH

THE PRAYERS OF THE MASS

The Eucharist is our greatest prayer. Together in the Mass, led by the priest, we participate in the praise of God for the history of our Salvation. If you listen carefully to the words of the Mass, you will hear the entire story of what Jesus did for us and how much He loves us. The songs we sing connect our emotions with this great prayer. The actions of the Mass help us to remember what is going to happen next. For example, when we stand for the Our Father, we know that the Peace is coming next.

FEAST OF CORPUS CHRISTI—JUNE 23

In celebration of Corpus Christi, we will have Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament starting Friday, June 21 until Sunday, June 23, closing with benediction at 7:45 am followed by 8:00 am Mass. We need volunteers to spend time with the Lord on each hour. Can you spend an hour with Jesus? The sign-up sheet will be in the Narthex. Feast of Corpus Christi (Latin for "Body of Christ") is a Catholic liturgical solemnity celebrating the real presence of the body and blood of Jesus Christ, the Son of God, in the elements of the Eucharist—known as transubstantiation...will you spend an hour with the Lord during those days? **Attention Volunteers:** Those who signed up for adoration between the hours of 7:00 pm to 7:00 am, entrance door will be at back of church (follow signs). Please do not leave until the next person shows up. It is very important not to leave the Blessed Sacrament unattended, which is why we need 2 or more people each hour especially at night and early morning.
