As I've lived through this, I've thought of what Jean Vanier wrote before he died: "I am not sure what the future will be but God is good and whatever happens will be the best." Peace and love to you all, for reassuring me that "whatever happens will be the best".

Old Testament

PURIFYING THE TEMPLE

1 Maccabees chapters 3 & 4

Judas the son of Mattathias became the warrior leader of the Jews who had escaped to the desert after the destruction of the temple. He was such a brave warrior that songs were written about him. "He pursued the wicked, hunting them out, and those who troubled his people he destroyed...All evildoers were dismayed." Judas defeated one general after another until they were able to return to Jerusalem and look at their temple. But what a terrible sight greeted them! The altar was desecrated (disrespected), the gates were burnt, there were weeds growing in the courts, and the chambers of the priests had been destroyed. They remembered Solomon's temple and how glorious it had been. So they sprinkled their heads with ashes and cried out to heaven. To re-establish the sacrifices they cleaned the temple, then made a new altar of uncut stones.

New Testament

FIVE LOAVES AND TWO FISHES

Luke 9: 1-17

After walking with Jesus for more than two years, Jesus decided to send his disciples on a mission. They were to go to every village with the power and authority to overcome all sorts of evil—including demons and many kinds of sickness. When Jesus came to earth he brought the power of Heaven with him and he shared his power with his disciples. This is true now! We can all share in the power of Jesus's love when we stay close to Jesus and "walk" with him. The disciples came back with wonderful reports of their mission. He wanted to take them to a quiet place, but they were followed by hungry crowds. Even after they had seen so many miracles, they didn't know that Jesus could feed so many people with only a little bit of food, five loaves and two fishes. After everyone was fed, they picked up twelve baskets of leftovers.

SPIRITUAL ADOPTION UPDATE—5TH MONTH

"Mommy felt me kick today!" This month marks the half-way point to birth and the baby is very active. Sleep habits develop and his mother can feel him move and stretch, particularly when he is resting. He is big and strong enough to kick hard against the outside uterine wall and dent it. Up to now, although he swam with ease in his watery world, he was too small for her to detect because the inside wall of the uterus has little feeling. The babies' hair and eyebrows begin to grow. The ears are fully formed and the baby responds to sound. He is able to hear his mother's heartbeat and voice. Many moms begin to sing to their baby at this stage. Babies born at this age have survived.
