JESUS TEACHES US NOT TO BE GREEDY



In today's Gospel reading, a man tells Jesus that his brother is being unfair to him. But Jesus knows that the man is just being greedy, so He tells him the parable of the rich farmer. One year the farmer had such a good harvest that he couldn't fit it all into his barns. He tore down his old barns and built new ones so that he could store his food for many years. But just when he thought he would be able to rest and enjoy his food, God told him his life on earth would be over.

This parable is a warning against being greedy. Jesus is not saying that we should not save some food or that we shouldn't save our money. He is just telling us to remember that we are not going to be here forever and that everything we save will one day be useless to us. He wants us to use the things we have wisely, but not be too attached to them.



Think of something that is really special to you. How would you feel if you lost it or it was taken away? Do your feelings show that you care too much about things? Try to think of your belongings in such a way that if you lost them you wouldn't be too upset.

SPIRITUAL ADOPTION—SIXTH MONTH (I'm Sitting up Straight Now!)

During the sixth month of life, our spiritually adopted babies will grow to 14 inches and increase in weight to 1 1/2 pounds. Oil glands and sweat glands are functioning: these help regulate body temperature. A white filmy layer covers the baby and protects her delicate skin from the surrounding amniotic fluid and from scratches as she twists and turns. This waxy substance, a sort of natural skin cream, will be quickly absorbed into her skin soon after she is born. By the end of the sixth month, the baby will weigh almost 2 pounds. She can now respond to sound. Her lungs are fairly well developed and babies born at this age—given proper care—have a 70% chance of survival.

I am sorry to be the bearer of bad news. The church was broken into and robbed at some point between Sunday late afternoon and Monday morning. The thieves broke into the room with the safe and then broke into the safe itself, which took a great deal of effort. Unfortunately, they got the collection from the weekend out of the safe. We are asking you, if you wrote a check for this weekend, to put a stop on the check. The police have asked us to let them know if anyone notices any attempts to cash the checks written for this past weekend. Please contact Kerri Foust in the office if you learn of anyone attempting to cash those checks. We've been told that the insurance for the Archdiocese will not cover the lost checks. So, if you wrote a check for this past weekend and are able to write a replacement check, the parish would greatly appreciate it. That is where we can use your help, along with your prayers for the conversion of whoever did this.

The police have been out and have processed the church. We are hopeful they will find evidence that will point them in the right direction. We are sorry for the inconvenience this causes you. Please be assured that we are heightening our security measures even further to ensure this doesn't happen again.

I hope that we will all pray for the conversion of whoever has done this. If we all pray for their conversion, I'm sure the Lord will help facilitate that.
