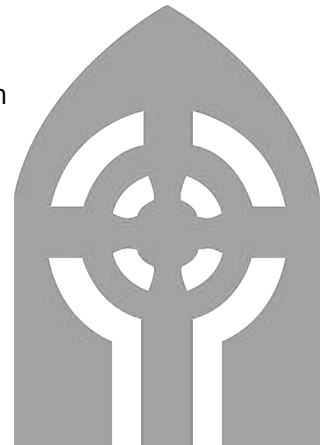

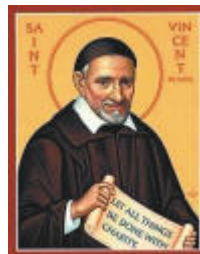

### **Old Testament**

#### **JEREMIAH'S MAIN MESSAGE**

##### **Jeremiah Chapter 22**

Jeremiah kept on sharing the words or messages he was getting from the Lord. He sometimes prayed complaining prayers, because people were laughing at him and criticizing him. "All the day long I am an object of laughter. Everyone mocks me." (20: 7) But he was always obedient. He went down to the potter's house to see how he made a clay pot. He went to the potter's field to smash a drinking cup. He told the people to go out to the Babylonians because their army had been sent by God. All of this was very unpopular, but he kept talking about God's main message.

- ♦ Do what is right and just.
- ♦ Rescue the victim.
- ♦ Take care of widows and orphans
- ♦ Do not kill innocent people.

If they would do these things, then Jerusalem would be saved.

### **New Testament**

#### **TWO BLIND MEN**

##### **Luke 18: 18-43**

Sometimes Jesus says that people are blind when they can't see the truth. A rich young man came up to Jesus and asked how he could find eternal life. Jesus knew that the young man followed God's laws carefully. So he gave him a new assignment—to sell all that he had, give the money to the poor, and then follow Jesus. What an amazing opportunity! But the rich man was "blind" to the wonderful chance to spend every day with Jesus. That is eternal life—following Jesus every day and right into the time after death.

Another blind man, sitting on a road near Jericho, heard that Jesus was passing by. He was only blind in his eyes, not in his heart. Unlike the rich young man, he knew why he wanted to see. He wanted to follow Jesus! After Jesus healed his eyes, the man started to follow.

## **MY FAITH**

### **Sacred Scripture**

Jewish people have a wonderful tradition. When a Bible becomes old and tattered, they don't throw it away. Instead, they put it in a great vault, treating the scroll or book with respect because the words were inspired by God. In Christian culture we truly love the Bible—both the Old and the New Testaments. We proclaim 4 Bible passages at every Mass, and we especially honor the Gospels. Open your Bible at random. Read the whole page on the left and the whole page on the right. See what God is trying to tell you.

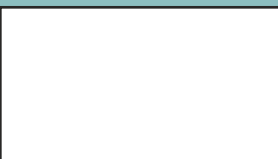
