

### Old Testament 'YOU WOULD NOT LISTEN"

### **Jeremiah Chapters 25-end**

Jeremiah shared the message he had from God, that because the people had not listened to the prophets, and had continued in the wrong way-cheating the poor, worshiping other gods, and not taking care of widows and orphans-that God would send the armies of Nebuchadnezzar to defeat the city and carry off many of its people to Babylon. A long time before, such a thing had happened to the kingdom of Israel in the north. The last king of Judah–Zedekiah– became so angry with Jeremiah that he threw him into a dry well. But one of the servants felt so sorry for Jeremiah that he convinced the king to bring him out. Jeremiah told the people to stay in Jerusalem, but many of them tried to escape to Egypt. Jeremiah was allowed to follow his people and until he died, he remained faithful to God.

### New Testament ZACCHAEUS

### Luke 18: 18-43

Zacchaeus was a tax collector. He worked for the Romans collecting money from the people. The tax collectors were hated by the people because they kept a lot of money for themselves. Zacchaeus was very short. When he heard that Jesus was coming through his neighborhood in Jericho, he really wanted to see Jesus. Because of the crowds of taller people, Zacchaeus climbed a tree where he could easily see what was happening. What a surprise when Jesus stopped beneath the tree and called him by name! Jesus told him that they would spend the day together in Zacchaeus's house. We don't know what they talked about, but by the time the day was over, the tax collector was a very different person. He wanted to give half his money to the poor and repay four times the amount that he had stolen over the years.
