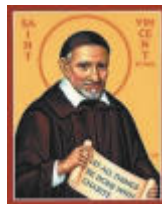

### **Old Testament**

#### **‘YOU WOULD NOT LISTEN’**

#### **Jeremiah Chapters 25-end**

Jeremiah shared the message he had from God, that because the people had not listened to the prophets, and had continued in the wrong way—cheating the poor, worshiping other gods, and not taking care of widows and orphans—that God would send the armies of Nebuchadnezzar to defeat the city and carry off many of its people to Babylon. A long time before, such a thing had happened to the kingdom of Israel in the north. The last king of Judah—Zedekiah—became so angry with Jeremiah that he threw him into a dry well. But one of the servants felt so sorry for Jeremiah that he convinced the king to bring him out. Jeremiah told the people to stay in Jerusalem, but many of them tried to escape to Egypt. Jeremiah was allowed to follow his people and until he died, he remained faithful to God.

### **New Testament**

#### **ZACCHAEUS**

#### **Luke 18: 18-43**

Zacchaeus was a tax collector. He worked for the Romans collecting money from the people. The tax collectors were hated by the people because they kept a lot of money for themselves. Zacchaeus was very short. When he heard that Jesus was coming through his neighborhood in Jericho, he really wanted to see Jesus. Because of the crowds of taller people, Zacchaeus climbed a tree where he could easily see what was happening. What a surprise when Jesus stopped beneath the tree and called him by name! Jesus told him that they would spend the day together in Zacchaeus's house. We don't know what they talked about, but by the time the day was over, the tax collector was a very different person. He wanted to give half his money to the poor and repay four times the amount that he had stolen over the years.

## **MY FAITH**

### **Salvation History**

God's love for his people has a long history. We can name many of the events that take place in the Bible.

1. Creation of the world.
2. Blessing the family of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob.
3. Moving the family to Egypt.
4. Calling Moses to bring the people out.
5. Settling in the promised land.
6. Working through prophets and judges.
7. Allowing the people to have kings.
8. The exile from the Promised Land.
9. Returning to Jerusalem.
10. Jesus's sacrifice and Resurrection.

God's action in human history continues today. When we participate in the Mass, help the poor, or tell others about Jesus, we are part of Salvation History.
