TOBIAH FALLS IN LOVE

Tobit 2: 11—6: 2-18

It was a long journey. When Tobiah and Archangel Raphael (going under the name of Azariah) stopped to cool off in the river, a fish tried to swallow Tobiah's foot. Raphael showed Tobiah how to save part of the fish's insides for medicine—which helps with our story. Raphael suggested that they spend the night with Raguel, a man of Tobiah's extended family. Raphael had the idea that Tobiah could marry Raguel's daughter Sarah. But Tobiah said no. He had heard that Sarah had already been married seven times, and that each husband died the very night of the wedding because of a fierce demon. But Raphael said that if he used the fish liver and heart for incense, the demon would run away and never come back. With that in mind, Tobiah did not hesitate to fall in love with Sarah.

New Testament

JESUS PREACHES IN GALILEE

Luke 4: 14-32

We know a lot about the miracles of Jesus. What we also should remember is that Jesus preached every place he went. The preaching and the miracles worked side by side to let people know about the Kingdom of God. It is a blessing that some of his disciples wrote down the words he said. In each village there would be a synagogue, a place of worship. Rabbis taught in these synagogues. Priests offered sacrifices in the Temple in Jerusalem. When the book of the prophet Isaiah was handed to Jesus he read these words, "The spirit of the Lord is upon me. He has anointed me. He has sent me to bring glad tidings to the poor, to proclaim liberty to captives, recovery of sight to the blind, and release to prisoners, to announce a year of favor for the Lord." He told the listeners that Isaiah's prophecy was about Jesus himself.
