##### THE WEDDING FEAST

###### Tobit 8: 1-21

Tobiah was getting ready to marry Sarah the daughter of Raguel. She had lost 7 husbands, all killed by a demon. ##### SIMON & ANDREW, JAMES & JOHN

###### Luke 5: 1-11

Jesus was walking by the Sea of Galilee where many fishermen worked. Two boats were moored by the side of the lake. The fishermen were on land and were busy washing their nets. Jesus got into one of the boats, and asked the owner Simon to get into the boat with him and pull out a little way from the shore. Now that funds were transferred most of the activities will kick-off including the construction of the shelter and repairing of the truck. An advertisement has been posted to hire a Parish Clerk to start April 1. The Projects Committee is set to facilitate the construction of the maizemill house and the water tank was re-installed. Thank God we now have running water. The new parish office bearers started operating and so far there seems to be good progress. There is an improvement on Sunday collections which hopefully will continue. We bid farewell to Seminarian Evance as he has finished his time here. We are hosting Bishop Montfort for a Pastoral visit March 13—17 and we pray for the success of his visit. Heavy rains have caused the bridge towards Mangochi to be washed away and there is currently no access to Mangochi until it is repaired." We send prayers for those affected by the flooding!
