The cost of this trip has been fully funded by the travelers themselves. We especially want to give a HUGE thanks to the Hispanic community for the donation of \$1,000 that was raised at the meal served after the 12:00 pm Spanish/African Mass on May 22nd. 5TH ANNUAL ST. BRENDAN CHARITY GOLF TOURNAMENT






