NEW TESTAMENT FRIEND-LYDIA

As Christianity started to spread to many places in the Roman empire, many



women—both rich and poor—became Christian. We know of one wealthy woman named Lydia who is mentioned in the Acts of the Apostles. You can read her short story in Acts 16:14-15.

Lydia lived in the Roman colony of Philippi. She first met Paul when he was with a group of preachers who visited a prayer group meeting beside a river. She listened to Paul's message and made up her mind that everyone in her household would be baptized. Lydia was a seller of purple dyes which were very expensive. This business may have earned her

enough money to have a large house. Lydia invited Paul and his companions to stay with her while they were in Philippi.

Lydia is a good example of taking the things that you have and using these things for God's glory.
