### DO YOU KNOW—The Sacraments in the Bible

(answers from the January 3 bulletin)



**1. BAPTISM**— Jesus goes to the Jordan River. (*Mark 1: 9-11*)

**2. CONFIRMATION**— The Holy Spirit descends on the Apostles, Mary, and others who were present. (*Acts 2: 1-12*)

**3. EUCHARIST**— Jesus gives bread and wine to the Disciples and institutes this Sacrament by saying “This is my Body, This is my Blood.” (*Mark 14: 22-36*)

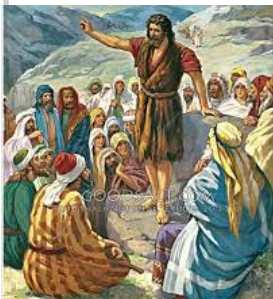
**4. ANOINTING OF THE SICK** —Jesus heals people who were sick. (*Mark 3: 1-6*)

**5. RECONCILIATION**— Jesus forgave even the people who were nailing him to his Cross. (*Luke 23: 32-34*)

**6. MATRIMONY**— Jesus’ first Miracle takes place at a familiar event, which is now a Christian Sacrament. (*John 2: 1-12*)

**7. HOLY ORDER**—S Paul reminded Timothy that he was chosen for ministry by the laying on of hands. (*1 Timothy 4: 14*)

### **NEW TESTAMENT FRIEND—JOHN THE BAPTIST**



We know John the Baptist almost better than we know anyone else except for Jesus. We know about his birth, his ministry, and his death. You can read about John the Baptist in all four of the gospels.

John’s very birth was a miracle. His parents were old and before he was born, they had no children. The great angel Gabriel came to John’s father to tell him that he and his wife would have a son.

In a famous scene in the Bible, John baptizes Jesus in the Jordan River. When Jesus came up out of the water, the Holy Spirit appeared in the form of a dove, and God the Father spoke from Heaven.

John died quite tragically when he dared to criticize the king. We remember him as a great saint and prophet because he always spoke God’s word, because he knew Jesus to be the Messiah, and because he taught people how to put God first.

## ANNUAL CATHOLIC APPEAL

Our goal for the Annual Catholic Appeal for this year is \$145,541. We have received pledges and one-time gifts of \$136,617 which leaves a balance of \$8,924 left to be pledged. If you have not made a pledge, please do so at your earliest convenience. We have collected \$124,462 of the amount pledged which leaves a balance of \$21,079 cash to collect. This means that if the ACA campaign was to end today, St. Brendan would have to send the Archdiocese a check for \$21,079.

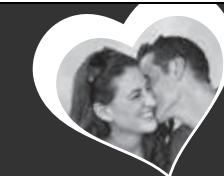
