Lent at St. Brendan

The Lenten season prepares us to celebrate the most important feast of the year, the Easter Triduum, when we commemorate the central events of our salvation: Jesus' last supper, death and resurrection. Lent originated in the church's earliest years as a special time for the catechumens—those preparing for initiation into the faith through Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist. The forty days are spent in prayer, fasting and penance as they prepare to be joined with Christ's death and resurrection through the Sacraments of Initiation.

Everyone needs a time of prayer and penance on a regular basis. To benefit the most from our observance of Lent today, it may be helpful to consider one of the Lenten Opportunities listed on this page. May our Lenten observance renew us and bring us to a meaningful celebration of Easter.

Lenten Disciplines

The Church calls all Catholics to observe Lent through ancient disciplines of prayer, fasting and abstinence from meat.
 ◇ **Fasting** on Ash Wednesday and on Good Friday. Catholics aged 18 through 59 years are required to fast. Fasting consists of one full meal with two smaller meals allowed if necessary.
 ◇ **Abstaining** from meat on all Fridays of the year except those 14 years of age and older. On Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and all the Fridays of Lent.
