"Dear Beloved Bothell—I am pleased to share with the progress of the project of the priest house (rectory) which is under construction. We believe this stride is not being made only through our effort but also through your fervent prayers. I love you all. Special greetings from Fr. Chris (pastor) to the entire community of St. Brendan in this Lenten season. In Christ and Mary, John Phiri (schoolmaster"

Please see the photos John sent that are posted on the Namalaka display board on the wall in the Narthex. The priest house is being built large enough to accommodate visitors. It is being constructed using bricks made from clay procured from the native soil. Malawi current facts: Poverty is rampant with 3 million people out of a population of 16 million expected to need food aid this year. Reliance is on crops of maize. Last year a drought followed by a flood wiped out the crops and this year the drought persists. They are in need of international aid and the government's help through importing corn. We are inquiring as to how the people in Namalaka are doing and what it is we can do to help. Please pray.
