1. Matthew 9: 1-8 This is the first miracle in the gospel of Matthew. Jesus heals a man who cannot move. What else does Jesus do?

2. Mark 1: 29-31 Peter's mother in law got busy as soon as she was healed. What did she do?

3. Luke 6: 12-16 Jesus heals the leper (a person with leprosy). After that Jesus tells the leper to go to the priest. Find out more about this command by going to Leviticus 13: 9.

4. The miracle in John 6: 1-15 is often called the Feeding of the 5,000. This happened near the time of a great Jewish feast. Can you find out what feast it was? See verse 4.

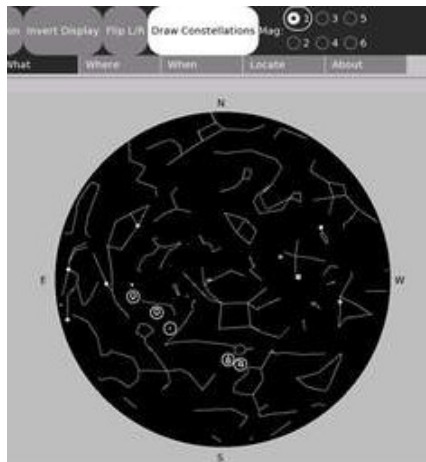
OLD TESTAMENT FRIENDS—Abraham's Big Family
