MALAWI MOMENTS: REPORT FROM MALAWI

On Monday, we visited the school and attended lessons in Form 1, 4 and 7. Form is the word used in Malawi for grade level. We visited with members from the parish and finance councils. After lunch we visited some of the sick in their homes. We took gifts of sugar, salt, soap and Sobo (an orange flavored beverage similar to Kool Aid). On Tuesday, we visited an out-church which included a health center and a school. Out-churches are known as mission churches in the United States. We were treated to songs from the choir and visited classrooms. In the afternoon we visited with the women who taught us how to make roasted corn and tomato sauce. Marie presented the gifts she brought to Fr. Chris and the women. We then met with the youth and presented them with the banner from the school and school supplies. After that we met with the Catholic Women's Organization group which was a highlight for us. Wednesday took us to Hippo Cottage on Lake Malawi for a couple of days relaxing. Hippo Cottage is owned by the Archdiocese of Blantyre and the nightly rates we pay, although low, help the Archdiocese with its work. We visited the Mua cultural center and Cape Maclear. The cultural center teaches visitors about the history of several tribes in the area as well as the story of the Catholic church and its evangelization efforts. Friday we returned home. For those coming to the auction, we have many great items. By the time you read this, Marie and Dena will be back in Bothell!

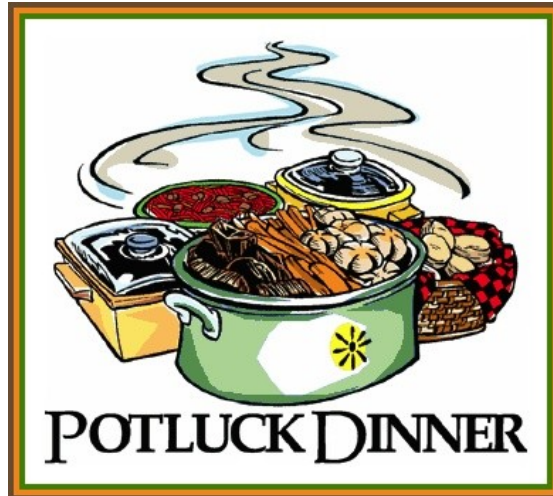

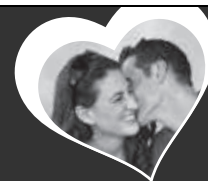
