Part 3 of Letter Read & Presented to the St. Brendan Delegation of Marie, Brigette and Dena on Sunday, June 12, 2016

Dilapidated structures: You can wish to recall that this parish has 5 out churches—Lupetere, Lugola, Saiti, Lugwena and Lashidi and Namalaka proper. This parish also has five primary schools namely St. Joseph, Lungwena, Mikombe, Unga1, Lugola and Luetere and two community Dy Secondary Schools (CDSS) namely St. Joseph CDSS and Lugwena CDSS. However, the buildings in the mentioned places are not worthy to be churches nor schools. They are in very bad shape. 4) Small church of Namalaka: As a parish there are times and occasions we need to gather as a whole and celebrate (combining all the out churches under one roof). For instance during Confirmation Mass, the feast of St. Joseph where we celebrate the patron saint of our parish, is too small to accommodate during festival season such as Christmas and Easter. This is evident today when other churches have not turned up but it is full to capacity already, thereby creating a demand for a bigger and magnificent one. 5) Preschool: St. Joseph as a whole has no preschool, be it for the church or the government. We feel it is of great significance that training received at an early grade determines the future of the church. I would like to conclude by assuring the parishioners of our Sister Parish, St. Brendan, of our continued support in various aspects spiritual, material and human resource. *Thank you all, Zikomo (thank you), Master Kamwendo*

JOSEPH'S BIG FAMILY

Joseph was born into Jacob's big family. There were 12 brothers and at least 1 sister. Joseph's mother was Rachel, and his only younger brother was named Benjamin. Joseph was definitely a little spoiled. Let's see why.

COAT OF MANY COLORS

Joseph and Benjamin were their dad's favorite sons, and the older brothers were understandably jealous. The most famous thing that Jacob did to show how much he loved his 11th son was to give him a Coat of Many Colors.

JOSEPH AND HIS BROTHERS

The time came that they decided to do something bad to this "dreamer" as they called him. Joseph had dreamed dreams about being greater than everyone. His brothers put him in a well, and then sold him as a slave.

JOSEPH IN PRISON

He was sold to an Egyptian slave trader who sold him as a house slave. While there even though he worked hard, he got in trouble with the boss and found himself in prison. While there he interpreted the dreams of some of his fellow inmates.

JOSEPH IN THE PALACE

He might have stayed there for a longer time, but the Pharaoh had a dream. Joseph was called out of prison to interpret the dream, one that turned out to be very important—about the famine that was coming. Joseph's central role in saving Egypt and the surrounding countries from starvation gave him enormous power, and the ability to help his family in a real way. He forgave everyone who had hurt him in the past and trusted God for a prosperous future.

Genesis 50:26 Joseph died at the age of a hundred and ten. He was embalmed and laid to rest in a coffin in Egypt.
