The Archdiocese of Seattle has provided us with a wealth of educational materials to help us learn Essential Concepts of the Catholic faith. Every week, we are going to explore one of these Essential Concepts.

**August 14—We Are Temples of the Holy Spirit**

Start by watching this cool youtube video which shows a 3D model of the Temple in Jerusalem, looking like it did at significant times in history. What is beautiful about this Temple?

The original temple constructed in the time of King Solomon was destroyed. Rebuilding the temple was the work of several kings, including Herod the Great, who lived during Jesus’ earthly ministry.

In Matthew 24 we read that Jesus’ disciples were very impressed with the beauty and size and grandeur of the Temple. In John 19: 2 Jesus says, “Destroy this temple and I will rebuild it in 3 days.” He was naming himself as the new Temple.

As children of God, Paul says (in 1 Corinthians 6: 19) that our BODIES are the temples of the Holy Spirit. What could that mean? It might mean that we are happy with the life God gives us, and it doesn’t matter whether someone is more beautiful or smarter than we are. It might mean that we ask God to help us stay away from dangerous substances. How can YOU be a Temple of the Holy Spirit?
