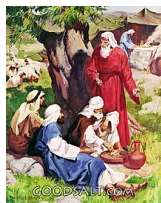

SALVATION HISTORY, part 2

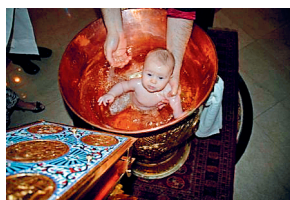
Last week we learned that we are part of a **Chosen People**.

- In the New Testament the Chosen people are the

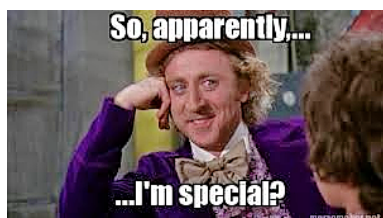
Disciples.
