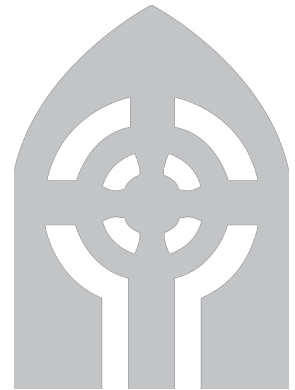

John excelled in school, studying the subjects of Agriculture, Chichewa (native language) English, geography, history, integrated science and math, bible knowledge, technology and social and development skills, graduating in 2003 and beginning his teaching career the next year. With further training John was appointed head teacher for St. Joseph Catholic Primary School in 2014. He chose to work in the Mangochi district to stay near his mother and younger brother. John is treasurer of the Parish Finance Council. He married Gloria in 2009 and have 3 children. John's interests include learning how people manage their jobs, especially administration, how to encourage the participation of the laity in church activities and exploring teaching methodologies.
