Our visitors from Malawi are now back home at St. Joseph in Namalaka. They gained lasting impressions of life at St. Brendan where they felt so welcomed and cared for. When asked what resonated with them, Angelina spoke of the bible study and how she could share openly. In Malawi, women are silent while the men talk openly. The women at St. Joseph do the cleaning, liturgy preparation, funerals and organizing all activities that support those in need. John was most impressed by the Children's Liturgy of the Word with the readings and lessons presented at their level of understanding. Fr. Chris felt he experienced the full understanding of the meaning of Catholic and universality of the church by celebrating the English and Spanish Masses and preaching on Mission Sunday. The Liturgy and baptisms are the same structure across the world. We celebrated on the eve of their departure with a square dance that was a fun raiser and fundraiser. The community of St. Brendan donated close to \$1,000 that will be deposited in the sister parish account to be used for the children and electricity.
