NAMALAKA NEWS—Malawi Culture as a Woman by Sister Parish Visitor Angelina Emmanuel, Head School Mistress ((Principal)

Part 1—The majority of people in Malawi are women. They are victims of social and economic inequalities arising from negative cultural practices, discriminating laws and policies. There is low women representation in key decision making positions. There is low participation of girls in math, science subjects and education at all levels. In the agricultural sector 70% of farmers are women yet access to land ownership and credit facilities is limited to women. Women should have a right to full and equal protection by the law. A fair share of property is owned jointly with their husbands. Due to some cultural reasons, however, it is observed that these women rights are violated in most cases. Culturally women are at a disadvantage in marriage, family and property rights due to low levels of literacy among them. Discrimination in work, business and public affairs exist. Women are discriminated against promotions even if they perform better than the men. They are sometimes denied loans by banks until the husband approves and are sometimes told to surrender their monthly salary to their husband.
