NAMALAKA NEWS—Malawi Culture as a Woman by Sister Parish Visitor Angelina Emmanuel, Head School Mistress (Principal)

Part 2—In regards to women's property rights, property grabbing happens soon after the death of a husband and even gratuity is not given to the wife. There are challenges in gender equity and fairness, in justice and the distribution of resources, benefits and responsibilities between men and women. There are abusive cultural practices that are forced on women such as rites of passages for girls coming of age and being forced into marriage at very young ages. Women are forced to perform rituals that are physically and emotionally degrading. Women and children are generally victims of gender-based violence. Psychological abuse takes place in the home in the form of excessive workload and being deprived of basic necessities, such as food and clothes by spouse. Spouses may prevent the woman from engaging in paid employment and from mixing with others. Women are prevented from getting an education by men. They have lack of funds to access appropriate service providers. Ouestions? Marie at 425-481-2484.


