MALAWI MOMENTS-NEWS FROM NAMALAKA...HUNGER FOR HOPE

"...the food we throw away is as if we had STOLEN it from the table of the hungry. I invite everyone to reflect on the problem of the waste of food to identify methods that may be vehicles for sharing and solidarity with the neediest."..Pope Francis

HUNGER IN NAMALAKA="the neediest." Right now, 6.7 million people in Malawi are in need of food. Children are most at risk from malnutrition as they cannot grow and attend to learning. Sometimes we use the phrase "I'm starving" when we mean we are hungry or ready for that next meal. "Starving" implies that we have not eaten and do not know when we may eat. Children in the States benefit from the school lunch program whereby they receive a hot meal. We, as a sister parish to St. Joseph in Namalaka have a chance to bring CHOW TO THE CHILDREN, providing the means that they eat a meal at school. We will send the funds directly to the parish school through our dear friend Bishop Montfort Stima, via the mission office. So eat those left-overs this week, don't go out to eat or have a simple soup supper and give what you save to feed the kids in Namalaka.
