SISTER PARISH ST. JOSEPH NAMALAKA, MALWAI—ST. JOSEPH SCHOOL FEEDING PROGRAM

In the last two bulletins we have described how dire and urgent the situation of hunger is right now. With your help, here is a plan of HOPE. *A report from John Phiri*—head school master who visited us in October: "I write on behalf of the parish school in regards to the food shortage in Malawi and the feeding program. St. Joseph Catholic Primary School has 2,524 students on roll with an average daily attendance of 2,275 students. The feeding ratios-since the feeding is done on a small scale and on self-sponsorship, the students are fed Mgaiwa (that is corn flour) which is cooked as porridge. When the porridge is prepared, each and every student gets a cup of porridge to help themselves for that school day which starts at 7:00 am and ends at 2:30 pm. It takes 2 bags of maize flour to feed 2,524 students for a day. We feed them 4 days a week and the term lasts 14 weeks. That requires 112 bags total. We need cooking oil and salt also. We ask students whose parent can afford it to take sugar from their homes to add to their cup of porridge. A bag of maize costs about \$20. In a nutshell, the cost is \$44 a day or \$175 per week.
