NAMALAKA NEWS FLASH

Thanks to the stewardship and generosity of our parish we have collected enough funds to feed the school kids of St. Joseph Parish for the school term now in session. It costs \$44 per day to provide a cup of porridge for lunch, which totals \$2,453 per 14-week term (fed 4 days per week). Our hope is to make this a sustainable, ongoing program to keep the children coming back to school day after day, allowing them to get an education that will benefit them throughout their lives. *A generous donor has come forward with \$7,000 of matching funds towards this goal of a school lunch program.* If we can raise \$7,000 in donations through future fund-raisers, we will be given the matching amount of \$7,000 which adds up to a whopping \$14,000. That will feed a lot of hungry children. In addition, our parish has already raised and recently sent \$8,000 to Namalaka for the project of bringing electricity to the new "fathers House" (rectory) and to the village (includes a transformer and the infrastructure) which will power a future maize mill bringing business to the area.

8TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Stewards of the mysteries of God—that's what St. Paul says we're in today's second reading. And the first requirement, he says, is that we be trustworthy. Entrusted with the gift of faith, do I share it as gratefully and as generously as I do my time, my talent and my treasure?

ARCHDIOCESAN PLANNING STUDY

Over the last several years it has become apparent that the archdiocesan priest pension and post-retirement medical plans are seriously underfunded. Similarly, our women religious must rely on dwindling resources within their own communities to meet their retirement needs. In addition, parishes have their own needs to address. At the recommendation of the Archdiocesan Finance Council and in dialogue with the Presbyteral Council, the Priest Pension Board and other leadership, Archbishop Sartain has decided to explore the possibility of a major campaign to address the retirement needs we face today and are projected to face in the future, as well as local parish needs. This planning study is an assessment to gauge support for a major campaign to address some or all of our identified priorities. The study is being administered by outside counsel, the Steier Group, a Catholic development firm. They will survey the entire archdiocese to determine which of our needs are deemed most urgent by parishioners, and identify potential support of a major campaign.
