NAMALAKA NEWS

"Dear brothers and sisters, greetings from St. Joseph Parish. It is winter here in Malawi. Usually this month is cold. People are starting to cover themselves with heavy coats. I am writing to update you on the feeding program. We have started very well during this third term. We are using some bags of maize we bought last term.

On May 13, we had a farewell party. We were bidding farewell to STD 8 students who are writing their examination that will allow them to enter secondary school. Feeding program has performed wonders. For the first time the school has 72 students who are sitting for the examinations. 44 are girls and 28 are boys. Out of 44 girls, 3 are young girls who have come back to school after giving birth to their first child. They came under back to school program. Join us in praying for their success in their examinations."
