*Pero la historia atrás de Las Aventuras del Bebé Moisés fué triste. Los hebreos fueron esclavos en Egipto.*



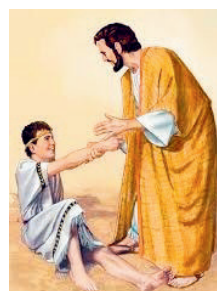
When you look at the giant pyramids of Egypt, you know that they were built by slaves.

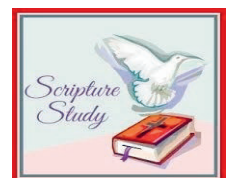
#### **Huge Turnout at the Parish Picnic!**
