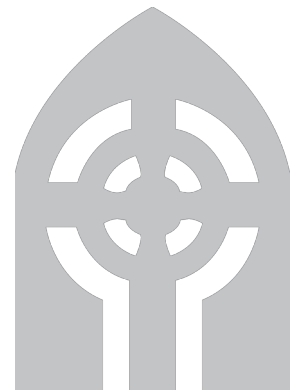

## **MALAWI MOMENTS HISTORY (Cont'd)**

In 2014 there were 7.5 million registered voters at least age 18 and 5.3 million turned out. A simple majority wins. The current president is younger brother to Bingu, Peter Mutharika. As a fairly new, struggling democracy they have problems with conflict and corruption, such as difficulties with poor infrastructure, tax base and money poorly managed by the government. With the current drought and famine situation, they have their work cut out for them. Stay tuned for biographies of the delegation visiting next month.
