## REPORTS

- Nancy's report: Nothing to report
- Pastoral council report (Linda): Disciples Club and sacramental prepartion classes are up to 146 participants. The council needs input on parish priorities for bugeting for the year. The council looked at the state of giving in the parish. The survey about changing the mass times had over 700 responses; no resolution to change times.

## **OLD BUSINESS**

- Multigenerational faith formation events to be held during Lent. Dates will be Wednesday nights,
  February 17 and 24, and March 2. Classes will focus on the corporal and spiritual works of mercy and
  confession. Agreed by the commission that teaching will be drawn from the *Material for Pastoral*Resources for Living the Jubilee booklets published by Our Sunday Visitor. A letter must be sent to
  Father Jim to formally recommend the classes.
- Linda outlined how the Spanish multigenerational Friday night faith formation classes are structured as a model that can be used for the proposed English multigenreational faith formation events, for which the Lent classes will be a trial.
- Formation needs to determine what are the basics of the faith that need to be taught and what resources are available for teaching them.
- Need to draft a commission charter/by-laws. Linda provided examples of other committee charters and recommended that we repurpose the faith formation section from *Many Gifts, One Spirit* that is available on the Archdiocese website.

## **New Business**

- Proposed and resolved to change the day of our commission meetings to the third Wednesday of the month. The first new meeting day to be Wednesday, February 17.
- Adult confirmation will be on March 5 (in English) and March 6 (in Spanish). Uncertain whether Archbishop Sartain will officiate or delegate to Father Jim.
