### **Old Testament** **EZRA READS THE LAW** **Nehemiah 8: 1-12**

After the Babylonian captivity, Jews who had been living away from Jerusalem were invited to come back to their homeland. Their most important work was to rebuild the temple which had been torn down. During the rebuilding they faced many challenges, including people who did not want them to rebuild. But the building went on until finally one day they were ready to remind people about the laws of Moses that we now find in the first 5 books of the Bible. They built a wooden platform at the Water Gate and Ezra stood on the platform from early morning until noon to read the books of God's law. The people were so overjoyed at having their religion restored to them that they were crying aloud. The scribes told them not to cry, but to be happy and give thanks to God.

### **New Testament** **FINDING JESUS IN THE TEMPLE** **Luke 2: 41-52**

Every year Mary and Joseph and Jesus would go to Jerusalem for the Feast of the Passover. Pass-over is the Jewish celebration of the time when their ancestors left Egypt. It represents not only their escape from slavery, but also the care that God showed them from the time they escaped from the Egyptian army until they crossed the Jordan River and entered the Promised Land. When Jesus was 12 years old, something strange happened. When Mary and Joseph were headed back to Nazareth, they realized that Jesus was not with them! Imagine how worried they were. They had kept God's Son safe through many dangers, and now he was gone. Sorrowful and very worried, they went back to Jerusalem. They found Jesus sitting in the Temple, teaching and asking questions of all the elders, who were amazed at his wisdom.

### **MY FAITH** **Personal and Social** **Sin (CCC 1846-** **1876)**

**When a person commits a sin, that means they have done something wrong and they knew it was wrong. We learn about right and wrong from our parents and from our Church teachings. This is called personal sin. Going to the Sacrament of Reconciliation means that we are truly sorry. God forgives us. There are also social sins, when a group of people forgets about God's laws of kindness and justice and mistreats another group of people. God calls us to repent of social sins.**
