#### **MATTATHIAS THE HERO**

#### **1 Maccabees chapter 2**

When the conqueror Antiochus Epiphanes took over Jerusalem, he started by stealing all the beautiful worship items from the Temple. But that was just the beginning. Soon the Jews found out that they were commanded to completely deny their religion and sacrifice to pagan idols. Mattathias was a priest who had five sons. They were all very committed to following God's laws. As the persecution grew worse in the cities, Mattathias moved out into the desert along with his five sons and their families. Many devout Jews followed them. They refused to sacrifice to pagan idols and they also refused to do any kind of work on the Sabbath, which was their holy day. Mattathias was very old. Before he died he reminded his family and all the people of Israel about their heroes who in past years had died rather than disobey God.

#### **New Testament**

#### **JAIRUS AND HIS DAUGHTER**

#### **Luke 8: 40-56**

Parents love their children and are naturally sorrowful when their children are sick. In the time of Jesus the medicines were very different than the ones we have today, and there were no hospitals. Jairus and his wife had a little daughter who was so sick that she was on the point of death. So imagine how happy Jairus was when he heard that Jesus was in town. He begged Jesus to come to his house. While they were on their way, a woman who had been sick for a long time came close enough to Jesus to touch the hem of his garment. Jesus turned around and saw her. He said, "Your faith has made you well. Go in peace." When they arrived at Jairus's house, the little girl had already died. Jesus brought her back to life, showing by this action that God will raise us from the dead.

## SPIRITUAL ADOPTION UPDATE—5TH MONTH

"Mommy felt me kick today!" This month marks the half-way point to birth and the baby is very active. Sleep habits develop and his mother can feel him move and stretch, particularly when he is resting. He is big and strong enough to kick hard against the outside uterine wall and dent it. Up to now, although he swam with ease in his watery world, he was too small for her to detect because the inside wall of the uterus has little feeling. The babies' hair and eyebrows begin to grow. The ears are fully formed and the baby responds to sound. He is able to hear his mother's heartbeat and voice. Many moms begin to sing to their baby at this stage. Babies born at this age have survived.

## PRAYERS FOR PEACE IN MALAWI

Reports on elections from John Phiri, former principal at Namalaka Village School. "The elections results regarding the presidential race were announced on May 27 and President Peter Mutharika was declared a winner. Peter Mutharika was the torch bearer for the DPP party, Lazarus Chakwera of the MCP came second and thirdly, the youthful leader we hoped would make it, Saulos Chilima of the UTM followed. The runners up have rejected the outcome of the elections and are asking the courts to nullify them and rule for a fresh rerun. The MCP leader has been aggressive to the extent of encouraging his supporters to march in the streets in protests. Sadly, the demonstrations have not been peaceful. Houses were demolished and people who supported the DPP were assaulted. Unfortunately, this has been frequent in the central region of Malawi, but the villages in the southern and northern regions have been coexisting peacefully."
