

Old Testament

THE ARK OF THE COVENANT

2 Macabees chapter 2

We first hear of the Ark of the Covenant in the book of Exodus. By the time of the Macabees, nobody really knew where it was. For centuries people have guessed where the Ark might be. There are even Hollywood movies about the "Lost Ark." In our Catholic faith, we believe that the Blessed Virgin Mary who carried Jesus in her womb is the new Ark of the Covenant.

The Ark was made of acacia wood, covered inside and outside with pure gold. There were gold rings on each side for poles of acacia wood, so that nobody would touch the Ark while it was being carried. The Ark contained Aaron's stick which budded, the 10 Commandments, and a jar of manna from the years in the wilderness. It is believed that Jeremiah hid the Ark in a cave when the Temple was destroyed and the Jews were exiled.

New Testament

Luke 10: 38-41

Martha was a good cook. She worked hard in the kitchen every day, and especially on those days when Jesus came to visit. Martha, her brother Lazarus, and their sister Mary lived together in the village called Bethany. They were special friends of Jesus. In the past, Jesus had healed Mary. The four people loved each other very much. One day when Jesus came to visit, Mary took her place on the floor by his feet just so she could listen to what Jesus had to say. Martha might have liked to listen also, but she felt like she must cook up a great meal. After a while she became resentful that Mary wasn't helping. Martha wanted Jesus to send Mary into the kitchen. But he would not do that. He knew that the best use of anyone's time was to listen to his teaching. Also-did Martha forget?-Jesus could feed five thousand people without anyone's help!

CALLED TO SERVE AS CHRIST CAMPAIGN

Why are we making changes to the priest pension plan funding model?

Over the years the Archdiocese has taken many steps to improve the funded status of the priest pension plans:

- Increased the amount from the Annual Catholic Appeal to the plans to \$1.6 million per year
- Increased billings to the parish contribution of the plan since 2008 currently \$10,000 per year, increasing by \$600 each year
- Raised the benefit eligibility age from 65 to 70
- Full benefit vesting age increased from 25 to 30 years, depending on date of birth
- Eliminated 3% extended service benefit

Despite these efforts, it was not enough to provide a sustainable path for the future. Based on independent actuarial studies, we know if we continue the pay-as-you-go approach, amounts billed to our parishes will continue to increase for the foreseeable future. A much better approach is to properly fund the plans with adequate capital so present and future generations of priests will have a secure retirement plan and the burden on our parishes will be reduced. Your charitable gift to the Called to Serve as Christ campaign will help the Archdiocese to build a future which answers Christ's call to serve for future generations.
