The Respect Life Committee will have a Play n' Pak in the Narthex marked "Spiritual Adoption" in which gifts for our adopted babies can be placed. Old Testament

PURIFYING THE TEMPLE

2 Macabees 10: 1-8

It's hard to believe how much the Jewish people suffered during the time of the Maccabees. The worst of the rulers was Antiochus. At the end of his life he decided to completely destroy Jerusalem. But being injured on the way to that great city, Antiochus decided to play it safe and to say that he was sorry for all the sins he had committed. Not knowing that God could see into his heart, he expected that God would be impressed by his words and would heal him right away. But that did not happen. After the death of the wicked ruler, the Jews restored the Temple and purified it, joyfully worshiping God in the place where his mighty name had been so disrespected. They struck a new fire from flint and used that fire for their sacrifices of thanksgiving. The Jews celebrated for eight days.

New Testament

HEALING ON THE SABBATH

Luke 13: 10-17

On his way to Jerusalem Jesus was followed by great crowds that kept growing. The Sabbath is what we call Saturday. To the Jews it is their holiest day of the week. Over the centuries many rules were developed to help people honor this holy day by doing no work. But sometimes the Sabbath rules were so strict that people found it hard to obey them. Jesus often healed on the Sabbath.

A woman who had suffered from a sickness for eighteen years was bent over and could no longer stand up straight. When Jesus saw her he put his hands on her and healed her. The chief of the synagogue (a local place of worship) criticized Jesus, saying he should have done his healing on a different day. Jesus told the man that this woman had suffered long enough. It was right to release her from her suffering on the Sabbath.
