#### **GOD RESTORES JOB'S LIFE**

#### **Job chapters 38-41**

Job's three friends who came to visit him in his trouble finally had nothing more to say. In trying to convince Job of their way of thinking they have presented their own ideas about how God treats us.

If you live a perfect life will you always be blessed? Job tried to live a perfect life but all of these bad things happened to him.

If you have sins that you haven't really thought about, will God punish you? Some of his friends thought so, but Job wasn't sure.

Finally God spoke to Job from the middle of a great storm. He asked, "Where were you when I founded the earth?" God asked Job whether he could make a crocodile (Leviathan) without help. ## **CALLED TO SERVE AS CHRIST CAMPAIGN**

**What is the benefit of our parish reaching its campaign goal?** The goals of this campaign are important to all Catholics in the Archdiocese of Seattle. Funds from this campaign will take care of our retired priests and women religious today and for future generations. In addition, it will reduce the parishes' financial burden of the "pay-as-you-go" model currently in place for the priest pension and retired priest medical plans.
