

Old Testament GOD RESTORES JOB'S LIFE Job chapters 38-41

Job's three friends who came to visit him in his trouble finally had nothing more to say. In trying to convince Job of their way of thinking they have presented their own ideas about how God treats us.

If you live a perfect life will you always be blessed? Job tried to live a perfect life but all of these bad things happened to him.

If you have sins that you haven't really thought about, will God punish you? Some of his friends thought so, but Job wasn't sure.

Finally God spoke to Job from the middle of a great storm. He asked, "Where were you when I founded the earth?" God asked Job whether he could make a crocodile (Leviathan) without help. Job realized that all of his complaining had been a lack of trust in God's infinite wisdom. God forgave him and restored his fortunes.

New Testament THE PRODIGAL SON

Luke 15: 11-32

CALLED TO SERVE AS CHRIST CAMPAIGN

What is the benefit of our parish reaching its campaign goal? The goals of this campaign are important to all Catholics in the Archdiocese of Seattle. Funds from this campaign will take care of our retired priests and women religious today and for future generations. In addition, it will reduce the parishes' financial burden of the "pay-as-you-go" model currently in place for the priest pension



and retired priest medical plans. Furthermore, the campaign will provide opportunities and resources to directly benefit parishes. The more funds a parish raises, the more it will keep. Fifteen percent of all money raised by a parish is returned to the parish. After a parish exceeds its goal, it will then receive 85 percent of ensuing dollars to accomplish projects that fit with its "Called to Serve as Christ" theme.
