## Old Testament PSALMS

The 150 Psalms in the Bible are true works of art—great poetry that really shows how people feel when they are talking to God.

Here is one with **good advice:** 

Happy the man who follows not the counsel of the wicked. (Psalm 1: 1) This psalm **tries to understand** why people don't trust in God:

Why do the nations rage and the peoples utter folly? The kings of the earth rise up...against the Lord. (Psalm 2: 1-2)

The psalmist **complains** to the Lord, "How many are my adversaries! Many rise up against me! (Psalm 3: 1)

A **favorite** is the 23rd Psalm where God is described as the shepherd. The Lord is my Shepherd, I shall lack for nothing. (Psalm 23: 1)

#### **New Testament**

## THE PRODIGAL (WASTEFUL) SON

Luke 15: 11-32

When you listen to this parable you might be more sympathetic to the younger brother, or to the older brother. A young man asks his father for the money he should have received after his father's death. The generous father gives him half of his money. The young man goes out and wastes all of it. After getting a job feeding pigs he starts to remember how well the servants were treated at his father's house. He thinks he will go back and ask for the job of a servant. Much to his surprise, the father is overjoyed to see him and throws a great feast in his honor. The older brother, who always stayed with his father and did nothing wrong, is angry and sulky. He doesn't give thanks for the gift of being safe at home. But his bad temper cannot ruin the party for the happy father.

## MY FAITH <u>Called to</u> Be Disciples

We love to read the stories of the disciples. Peter and Andrew and James and John were called by Jesus when they were busy fishing as they did every day. The call of Jesus was so exciting to them that they dropped everything and followed Jesus wherever he went. We might wonder what that would have been like, so long ago. But we are all called to be disciples. We are all called to drop everything and follow Jesus wherever he leads. Jesus might lead us to being a mom or a dad, or a priest, a deacon, a bishop, or a teacher. The main thing is to pray to find God's call.

<u>All</u> campaign funds raised will be put toward the needs and priorities identified in the campaign



case book and on the campaign website. **None** of the campaign funds raised are going to the Archdiocese of Seattle for operating expenses. If the campaign raises more than our \$100 million goal, those funds will still only be used towards the needs identified in the campaign case statement and returned to parishes at a greater (85 percent) share.

In our parish, the money raised will be used for the Enrichment of the Sanctuary. The remainder will be used to support the retirement and medical needs of our priests and sisters throughout the Archdiocese.
