

RESPECT LIFE COMMITTEE PARENTAL NOTIFICATION PETITION, I-1004

Washington State Law allows a minor child to obtain an abortion without her parents' knowledge. The Catholic Bishops of Washington State strongly support and encourage gathering signatures on a petition Initiative I-1004, an initiative to institute a "parental notification law" that will require physicians to notify parents or guardians before performing abortions on minors. If you are registered to vote in Washington and haven't signed the petitions, please consider doing so this weekend of December 28/29 in the Narthex after all Masses.

Saints This Week

(adapted from <u>Companion to the Calendar</u> by Mary Ellen Hynes)

Dec 29—Saint Thomas Becket

St. Thomas Becket lived from 1118 -1170, so he was 52 when he died by the order of King Henry II, who had once been his best friend. King Henry chose Thomas to be Archbishop of Canterbury so that he (the king) could control the Church in England through his friend Thomas. However, Archbishop Thomas took his calling very seriously, living a simple life and helping the poor. He always defended the right of the Roman Catholic Church to be ruled by the Pope in Rome.

December 29—Saint David

The great people of the Old Testament who loved God are saints.

David had a strong love for God, pouring out his heart with psalms which we still sing in church. Jesus is often called "Son of David."

New Testament THE PASSION OF OUR LORD

Luke 22: 39–23: 56

After the First Eucharist in the city of Jerusalem, Jesus and his Disciples went out to the Mount of Olives where he prayed. The disciples wanted to watch and pray with him but they fell asleep. This is why many Christians spend one hour out of every day or every week in Adoration before the Blessed Sacrament to be with Jesus in his sorrow and to ask for his help. The facts have been told so many times, how Jesus was arrested and then taken to the temple area for trial. He was sent to the Roman ruler Pontius Pilate. Pilate wanted to release him but the temple rulers insisted on the death penalty. Jesus was led away carrying his own cross and was crucified at the hill named Golgotha. He forgave all his tormentors, and even told the thief who was crucified with him that they would meet in Paradise.

MY FAITH

The Blessed Trinity

The Blessed Trinity is Father, Son, and Holy Spirit—One God. There are many ways to try to understand God. Some people draw a triangle. The sides are all the same length and the angles are the same to show that The Father and The Son and The Holv Spirit are all equal. St. Patrick used a threeleaf clover to show that even though there were three leaves there was only one clover. Some people talk about The Blessed Trinity as a family. Just like in a family there can be three people—the Smiths or the Millers—there are a dad, a mom, and a child. When we think about something a long time and still have more to think about, that is called a Mystery. We see the Father, the Son, and the **Holy Spirit together in** the Baptism of Jesus. 
